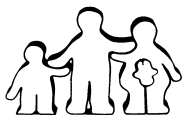
Learning objectives

- ✚ Participants will gain an understanding of the oral health needs of pregnant women and children as they relate to healthy birth outcomes, and maternal and child health.
- ✚ Participants will be trained to conduct an oral health screening and provide basic oral health education to consumers and to patients as reflected in the updated Prenatal Care Service Standards.
- ✚ Participants will receive an “oral health toolkit” for use in their practice or programs, including educational resources and starter supplies for conducting screenings, as well as a list of dental providers.
